


- Spirit is mentioned 19 times in Romans 8.
- Spirit is mentioned 15 times in verses 1-17.




Romans 8:5-14

- ⁵ For those who are according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those who are according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit.
- ⁶ For the mind set on the flesh is death, but the mind set on the Spirit is life and peace,
- ⁷ because the mind set on the flesh is hostile toward God; for it does not subject itself to the law of God, for it is not even able *to do so*,
- ⁸ and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.




Romans 8:5-14

- ⁹ However, you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. But if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Him.
- ¹⁰ If Christ is in you, though the body is dead because of sin, yet the spirit is alive because of righteousness.
- ¹¹ But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.






Some Questions

- When do we finish that work? (When do we finally kill the flesh?)




The Mortification of the Flesh


What is Sanctification?

"The work of God's free grace whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness."






Galatians 5:17

- ²⁵ If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit.




Colossians 3:10-17

- ¹⁰ and have put on the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created him--
- ¹¹ a renewal in which there is no distinction between Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all.
- ¹² So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience;
- bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.
